



MESA-OUTREACH, INC. announces the 2022 MESA-OUTREACH Scholarship Awards Program. Under the Program, on (1) \$1,000 scholarship funded annually for up to four years: \$4,000 total, (a minimum 2.5GPS must be maintained) will be awarded to a graduating high school senior from a volunteer or a family in need that is part of the MESA-OUTREACH community.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking graduating high school senior with a record of community volunteerism in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- Applicants must plan to attend a two (2) year community college or four (4) year college or university.
- Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of August 2022 directly to the college, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which included the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- Applications must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- Applications must be received by MESA-OUTREACH no later than April 15, 2022. Late applications will not be accepted.
